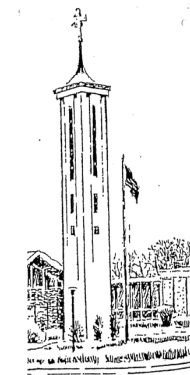
Rummage Sale date is March 20. Rummage items may be stored in the breezeway.
