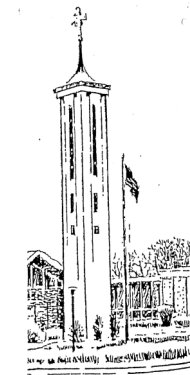

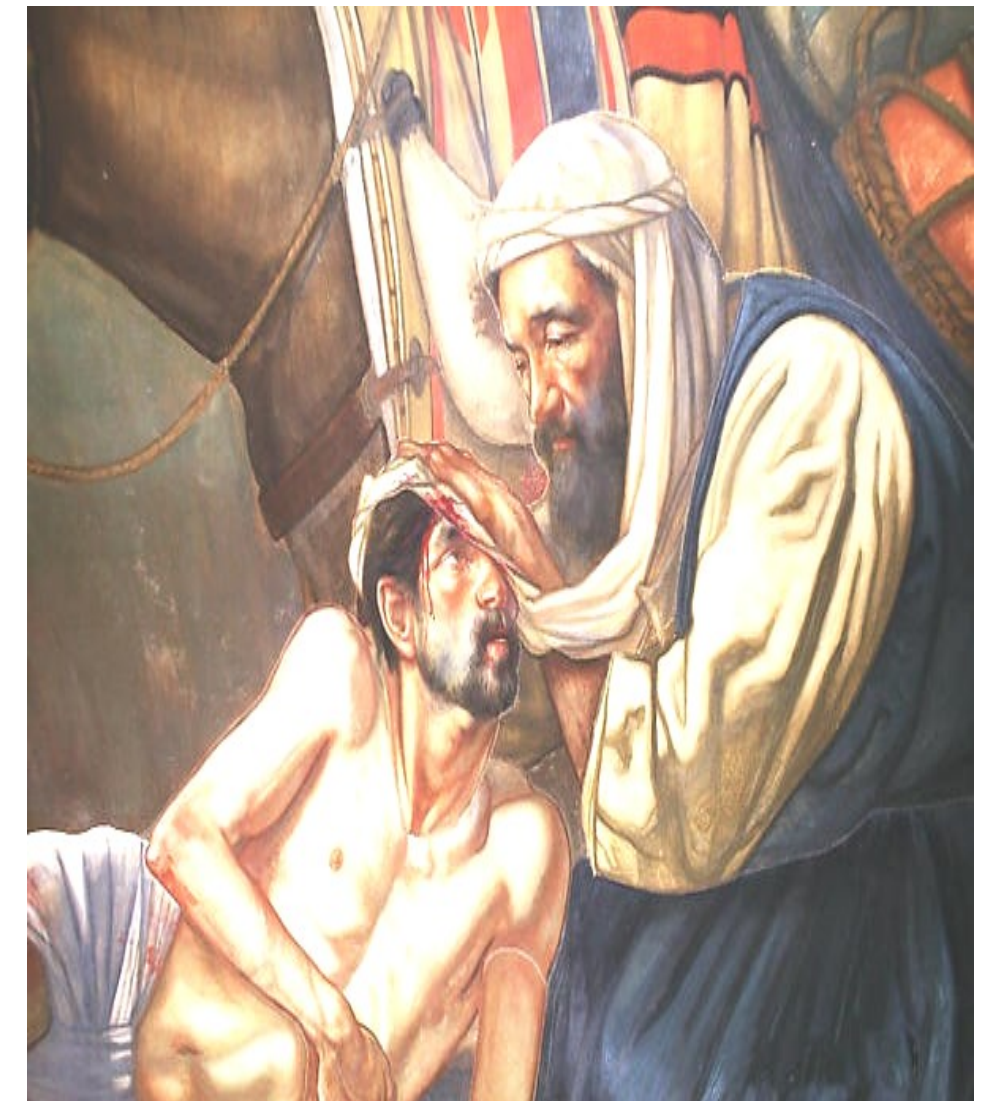

**"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy." One day an expert in religious law stood up to test Jesus by asking Him this question:**

*"Teacher, what must I do to receive eternal life?"* Jesus replied, "What does the law of Moses say? How do you read it?"

The man answered, *"You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength, and all your mind." And, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'* "Right!" Jesus told him. "Do this and you will live!" The man wanted to justify his actions, so he asked Jesus, *"And who is my neighbor?"*

Jesus replied with an illustration: "A Jewish man was traveling on a trip from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he was attacked by bandits. They stripped him of his clothes and money, beat him up, and left him half dead beside the road.

"Now which of these three would you say was a neighbor to the man who was attacked by bandits?" Jesus asked. The man replied, *"The one who showed mercy."* Then Jesus said, "Yes, now go and do the same."
