**SERMON OUTLINE**

**"THREE CHEERS FOR YOU!"**

Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 6:45-61; John 16:29-33

**"These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full." (John 15:11, NASB)**

If you are down, Jesus wants to cheer you up! In fact, Jesus has "three cheers for you!"

1.) **The first cheer is the cheer of forgiveness.** (Matthew 9:1-8) Jesus heals the paralytic and says to him, "Son, be of good cheer, your sins are forgiven." The Living Bible puts it this way, "Cheer up son! For I have forgiven your sins!"

Jesus forgives our sins and wants us to learn how to forgive ourselves.

2.) **The second cheer is the cheer of confident faith in Jesus** (Mark 6:45-61) The disciples are in a boat and they are struggling with the oars to make it to the other side. Jesus sets out to help them, walking on the water. The disciples panic and think they are seeing a ghost. Jesus speaks to them to calm their nerves, "Be of good cheer. It is I, be not afraid."

Like the disciples, we get up tight and afraid. Jesus assures us that He is with us, that we don't have to be afraid. Jesus says to His disciples and to you and I - "Give me your fears!"

3.) **The third cheer is the cheer of overcoming power in Jesus.** (John 16:29-33) The cross looms in the future. Jesus is teaching His disciples about prayer and He finishes, saying, "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you might have peace. In the word you will have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Jesus knows that in life we will face difficulties, trials, tribulations, and sorrows - but He has overcome the world!~And He says to us, "Life can do its worst to you - and you too, can emerge victorious. You too can possess the courage and the conquest of the cross and the resurrection. Be of good cheer - I have overcome the world."

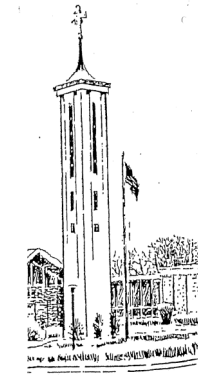

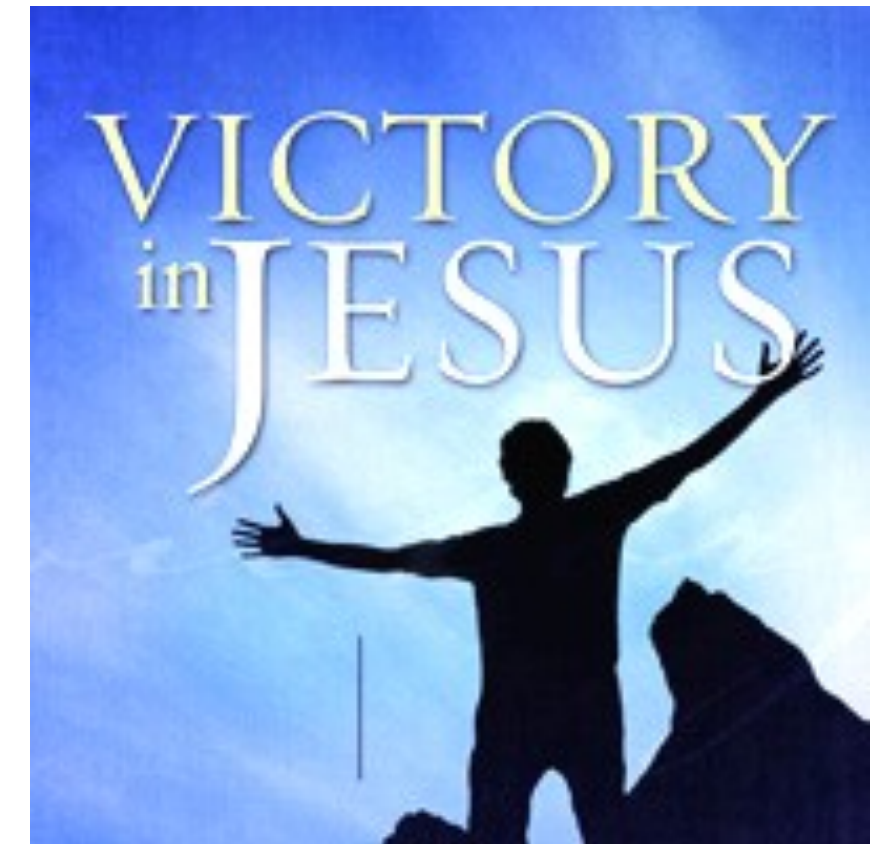

SCRIPTURE Matthew 9:1-8; Mark 6:45-52; John 16:29-33 (NKJV)
" So He (Jesus) got into a boat, crossed over, and came to His own city.

Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you."

At once some of the scribes said within themselves, "This Man blasphemes. But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins" – then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." And he arose and departed to his house."

"Immediately He made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, to Bethsaida, while He sent the multitude away. And when He had sent them away, He departed to the mountain to pray. Now when evening came, the boat was in the middle of the sea; and He was alone on the land. Then He saw them straining at rowing, for the wind was against them. Now about the fourth watch of the night (4 a.m.) He came to them, walking on the sea, and would have passed them by. And when they saw Him walking on the sea, they supposed it was a ghost, and cried out; for they all saw Him and were troubled. But immediately He talked with them and said to them, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid." Then He went up into the boat to them, and the wind ceased. And they were greatly amazed in themselves beyond measure, and marveled. For they had not understood about the loaves, because their heart was hardened."

His disciples said to Him, "See, now You are speaking plainly, and using no figure of speech! Now we are sure that You know all things, and have no need that anyone should question You. But this we believe that You came forth from God."

Jesus answered them, "Do you now believe? Indeed the hour is coming, yes, has now come, that you will be scattered, each to his own, and will leave Me alone. And yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me. These things I have spoken to you, that In Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."
