SERMON OUTLINE

"HISTORIC MARKER"

Joshua 4:1-9; Deuteronomy 6:4-13, 24

God commanded the Israelites to place rocks together – to remind them of their faith and dependence upon God. He wanted them to do this so they would remember the Rock – God Himself – and His steadfast faithfulness to His people. From Joshua 4 we can learn at least three things:

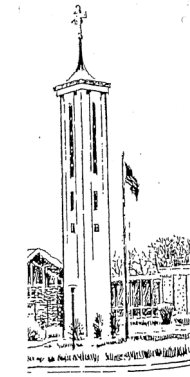
- God wants us to go to the trouble of establishing historic markers. God cares about our remembering Him and what He has done.** (Psalm 105:5; 103:2)
- God cares just as much that our children remember Him and what He has done.**

Before Joshua and the Israelites prepared to cross the Jordan River – Moses had taken the time to prepare them for their new lives by reminding them of God's law and God's love – by passing on the faith. There are three essentials for passing on your faith:

- Love God.** (Deuteronomy 6:5)
- Teach your children.** (Deuteronomy 6:7a)
- Don't forget.** (Deuteronomy 6:10-12)

When we love God wholeheartedly – and teach our children to do the same thing – we protect their faith from becoming diluted or polluted by society that surrounds them. Remembering and fearing God – revering God – helps them maintain their faithfulness to Him. Therefore, which historic markers should we concentrate on building for the generations after us? Here are four suggestions:

- God is love.** (1 John 4:8)
- God is holy.** (1 Peter 1:15)
- God is faithful.** (Lamentations 3:22-23)
- God is sovereign.** St. Augustine: "We can count on God's mercy for our past mistakes – God's love for our present needs – and God's sovereignty for the future."

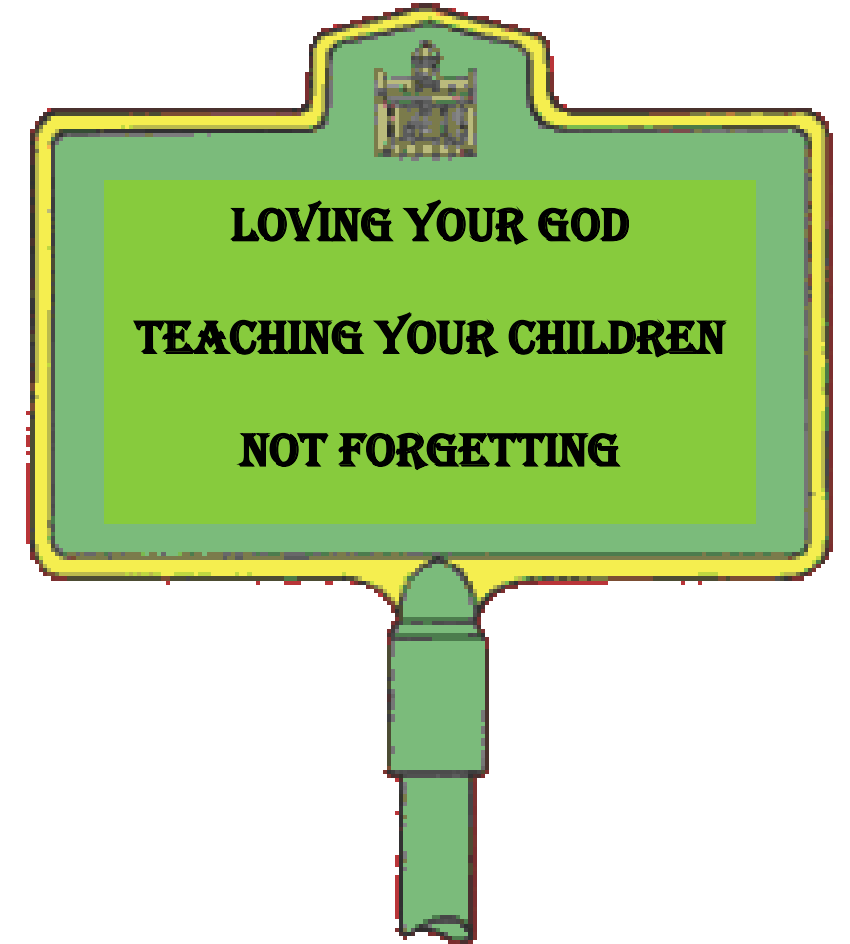

SCRIPTURE Deuteronomy 6:4-13, 24 (NLT)
"Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your strength. And you must commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands I am giving you today. Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are away on a journey, when you are lying down and when you are getting up again. Tie them to your hands as a reminder, and wear them on your forehead. Write them on the door-posts of your house and on your gates.

The Lord your God will soon bring you into the land He swore to give to your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. It is a land filled with large, prosperous cities that you did not build.
