Lettuce Eat Well Farmer's Market continues to meet on Fridays at CUMC through the winter months. They are open from 3-7 PM.

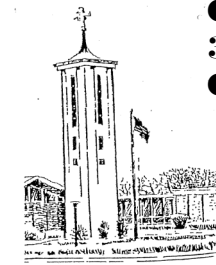
